Painless performance

If you have always believed that driving a high-speed performance car means folding yourself into a cramped and claustrophobic cockpit, it's time you experienced a Bentley.

Ever since the early days of the marque's five Le Mans victories, Bentley has recognized that performance is about both speed and stamina. And that means creating a driver environment that allows relaxed concentration for marathons as well as sprints.

Today, the Arnage Long Wheelbase takes performance and comfort to a new level. Under the hood, 400 bhp awaits your command. Inside, sumptuous Connolly hide and unbleached burr walnut veneer cosset the occupants. So when the Bentley engine stretches its legs, so can you.

The Arnage Long Wheelbase's 6.75 litre turbocharged V8 develops 400bhp at 4000rpm and 616 lb.ft. of torque at 2100 rpm, giving instant response in any gear, at any engine speed. The chassis and suspension feature double wishbone independent suspension both front and rear, ASC traction control and power assisted braking system with four-channel anti-lock control. Inside, with an additional ten inches of rear legroom, the compartment of the Arnage Long Wheelbase offers even more space to stretch out and enjoy travelling in a hand-built cocoon of leather and wood.

Luxurious touring saloon, or exhilarating performance car? Both: it's a Bentley.

- 1 Parchment dials communicate with classic English understatement. Tachometer is red lined at just 4,500rpm, evidence of the mountainous torque the Bentley puts at your disposal from idling speed upwards.
- 2&5 Veneered picnic tables, (companion mirrors cost option - USA) and door panels display Crewe craftsmanship at its best.
- 3 Heating, ventilation and air conditioning is controllable both side to side and front to rear, with pollen and dust filters, dehumidifier and residual heating.
- 4 Bentley bodywork goes through 16 stages and 120 separate processes.
- 6 The Arnage Long Wheelbase is capable of 155mph where conditions permit, with acceleration to match.
